Mark 1:40

A leper came to him begging him, and kneeling he said to him, "If you choose, you can make me clean."

Mark 1:41-42

Moved with pity, Jesus stretched out his hand and touched him, and said to him, "I do choose. Be made clean!" Immediately the leprosy left him, and he was made clean.

Mark 1:27-28

"What is this? A new teaching—with authority! He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey him." At once his fame began to spread throughout the surrounding region of Galilee.

Mark 1:35-37

In the morning, while it was still very dark, he got up and went out to a deserted place, and there he prayed. And Simon and his companions hunted for him. When they found him, they said to him, "Everyone is searching for you."

Mark 1:38

He answered, “Let us go on to the neighboring towns, so that I may proclaim the message there also; for that is what I came out to do.”
